You Are Protected



It is against the law for your employer to retaliate against you.

Immigration Status



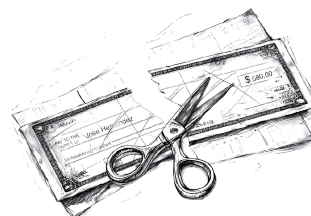
You are protected regardless of immigration status.

Retaliation



Retaliation occurs when your employer punishes you because you took steps to exercise your labor rights.

Example



You report unsafe working conditions to your employer and they punish you by reducing your hours.

If You File a Complaint



Your employer is required to stop retaliation. They may also be required to pay for your lost wages and rehire you.
